It has always been the endeavour of the Board to identify and recommend the best talent as per needs and requirements of the ICAR. The long pending demand of scientific community for fine-tuning of the score card for direct recruitment has been implemented with effect from the advertisement being released from January, 2016 onwards (Advt. 1/2016). The revised score card addresses and provides a level playing field and weight



age for both the field-oriented and lab-oriented scientists at the screening stage.

During this period, the Board has completed recruitment process for 51 positions in the scientific cadre based on lateral entry. Only four positions could not be filled up due to non-availability of suitably qualified and experienced applicants. About 150 proposals for placement as Principal Scientist under the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) are under process.

The result of NET 2015 Exam has been declared and certificates of 4148 successful applicants have been issued. The NET Examination 2016 (I) is scheduled to be held from 1<sup>st</sup> to August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 23 centres across India in on-line mode.

Continuing in our efforts to tap the best talent as per the needs and requirements of the Council, the Board has taken up the additional responsibility of conducting a Common Written Examination for filling up vacancies of Technical Assistant (T-3) and Technician (T-1) at the various ICAR institutes. The other examinations scheduled in the near future are for filling up positions of LDCs at the ICAR headquarters and institutes and Stenographer Grade-III.

The Board had declared the results of 45 class I positions of Administrative and Finance & Accounts Officers. The results of the Assistant Examination for filling up 309 positions has also been forwarded to the ICAR headquarters. About 45% of the candidates selected for the position were possessing degrees in Engineering.




### Recent Achievemtns

### **Direct Recruitment/Lateral entry**


The Board completed the recruitment process for fifty one posts during the period. Of these, 18 posts were Research Management Positions (Directors of National Institutes, Assistant Directors General, Project Directors, Joint Directors of National Institutes), 33 posts were for Head of Divisions, Project Coordinators and Principal Scientists. The Board recommended in 47 cases while only four posts could not be filled due to non-availability of suitable candidates.




Details of Direct Recruitment posts

Recruitment details of Directors, Project Directors and Zonal Project Directors




Recruitment details of Project Coordinators, Heads of Divisions and Principal Scientists

# Recruitment through Competitive Examinations

### **Agricultural Research Service Examination-2015**


Combined examination for NET and ARS (Prelims) 2015 was conducted in online mode at 22 centres across India except Chennai centre. The examination at Chennai centre could not be held due to unforeseen rains and floods in and around Chennai. It was subsequently held during January 6-12, 2016. Out of 9,936 appeared candidates in Preliminary Examination 2,217(22%) candidates qualified for Main Examination. ARS Main Examination was conducted on May 8, 2016 at 12 Centres. Out of 2,217 candidates 1,764 (80%) were appeared for 97 vacancies in 30 disciplines. Evaluation process of Main examination is under progress.

### NET Examination 2015


A total of 30,066 candidates had registered for the NET Examination 2015 and 21,478 candidates appeared in the examination. A total of 4,148 candidates (19%) qualified the examination.



Details of NET Examinations held in 2015


The lowest percentage of candidates was qualified the discipline of Home Science (1.36%) and highest percentage of candidates qualified was the discipline of Floriculture & Landscaping (65.90%) followed by Veterinary Anatomy (61.02%), Reproduction Animal & Gynaecology (52.17%),Technology (47.19%), Seed Science & Livestock Product Technology (44.32%) and Fish Nutrition (42.11%). In 10 disciplines, the success rate was less than 10%.

Analysis of the data showed that out of 4,148 qualified candidates, 1193 (28.76%) were from General Universities / International Universities with Agriculture Faculties, 1017 (24.52%) from ten State Agricultural Universities (T.N.A.U., Coimbatore; U.A.S., Bangalore; G.B.P.U.A.&T., Pantnagar; A.N.G.R.A.U., Hyderabad; U.A.S., Dharwad; P.A.U., Ludhiana; C.C.S.H.A.U., Hisar; B.C.K.V., Nadia; Dr Yashwant Singh Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry, Solan and U.H.S., Bagalkot), 418 (10.08%) from Deemed to be Universities (I.A.R.I., New Delhi; I.V.R.I., Izatnagar; N.D.R.I., Karnal and C.I.F.E., Mumbai, 1461 (35.22%) from rest of SAUs and 59 (1.42%) from Central Agricultural Universities.




Organization wise performance in NET Examination 2015

State-wise distribution remained skewed. 66% of successful candidates came from 11 states (Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana and West Bengal). States like Chhattisgarh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Goa, and Daman and Diu, had very little representation in the list of successful candidates.



State wise details of successful candidates in NET Examination 2015


Among the 4,148 qualified candidates, 43% were female candidates.




Gender wise details of successful candidates in NET Examination 2015

# Recruitment of Administrative Officers and Finance & Accounts Officers

Based on performance of candidates in the written examination and Structured Interview/Personality Test held in February, 2016, 32 candidates have been recommended for appointment to the post of Administrative Officer and 13 for Finance and Account Officer. Details are as follows:

### Recruitment of Assistants

An all India online open competitive examination for recruitment of 309 Assistants (DR) was conducted from January 5 to February 2, 2015. Out of 6,255 appeared candidates in the main examination which was held across 12 centres in India on October 18, 2015.

- The analysis further revealed that all the advertised vacancies were duly filled under various categories of candidates with maximum candidates under General Category (172 including 5 Divyang candidates), followed by Other Backward Class (72 including 3 Divyang candidates), Scheduled Caste (40) and Scheduled Tribe (25).
- This year, out of 309 selected candidates, 26.5% were females.
- The analysis of educational background of selected 309 candidates revealed that 129 candidates have B. Tech or BE degree. The complete analysis is given below.
